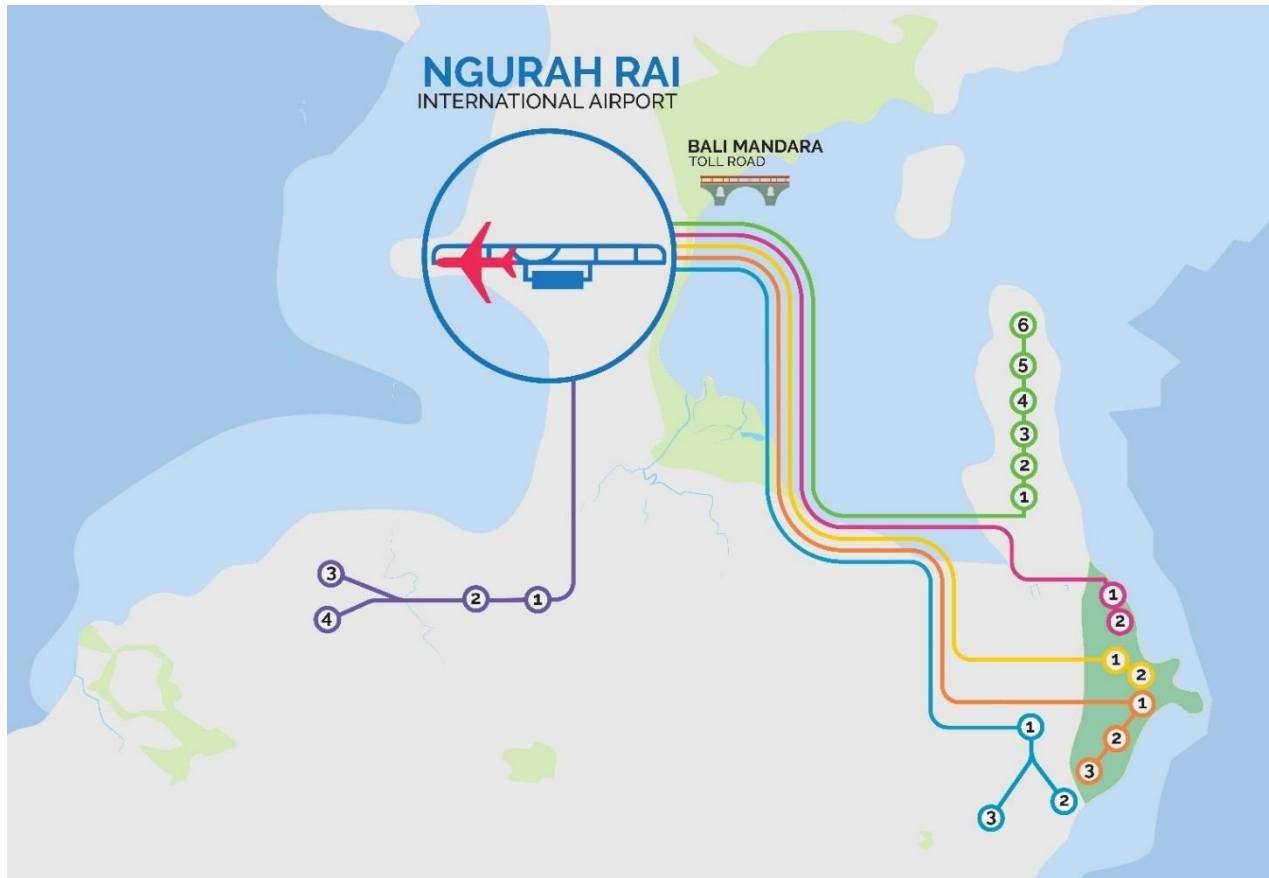
Information desk is available at Ayodya Resort Bali for transportation

- Lunch will be provided for all participants at the end of the seminar at the venue, Ayodya Resort Bali, Nusa Dua, Bali.

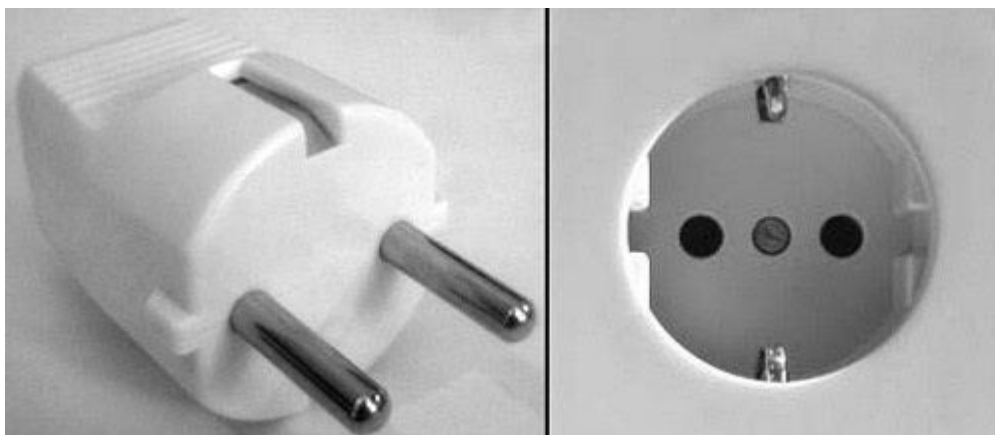
## 11. GENERAL INFORMATION

### *Time*

The hour in Indonesia Capital City Jakarta is + 7 relative to the Greenwich timeline. However, the hour in Bali is + 6 relative to the Greenwich timeline.

### *Electricity*

220 volts are used in Indonesia. Always make sure that you check the power supply before using your equipment. Check your need for a power plug (*travel*) adapter in Indonesia. In Indonesia the power sockets are of type C and F.



### *Weather*



Indonesia has an almost entirely tropical climate, including in Bali, the temperature in Bali can reach +/- 30 degrees Celsius, with high moisture level around 80%.

*Things to be considered:*

- Dehydration  
All the participants need to ensure adequate fluid intake to prevent dehydration.
- Personal Medicine  
All participants should carry an adequate supply of medication.

**Currency**

- Indonesian currency is Rupiah (Rp). The Rupiah comes in denomination of Rp100.000, Rp50.000, Rp20.000, Rp10.000, Rp5.000, Rp2.000 and Rp1.000 in bank notes, and Rp1.000, Rp500, Rp200, and Rp100 in coins.
- Major foreign currencies are exchangeable at State Banks such as Bank Mandiri, Bank Negara Indonesia, and Bank Tabungan Negara and other private Banks such as Bank Central Asia, Bank CIMB Niaga, and Bank Permata. Money changer is easily found in the airport and some tourist destinations.
- Major credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club) and most traveler's checks are accepted.

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
